BOARD MEETING MINUTES

June 17, 2024

Call to Order: 7:03pm

Officer & Staff Reports

• President – Welcome All, thank you for making the time to be on the call.

NCASA teams did very well at the USASA Region III Amateur Championships.

NCASA has three Region III Champions.

-Men's Amateur Championship - Tobacco Rd. FC defeated North Texas, Florida, Georgia in group play and defeated NPSL Naples FC. for the Championship.

-Women's Amateur Champion – Winger FC. Played in a group of five and went undefeated against North Texas, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina's Carolinas Cup finalists, Shot Callers.

-The Men's Over 40 Championship went to the Wanderers FC from Winston Salem. This will be their first regional title after being in multiple championship matches.

NCASA also had three Finalists at the event; GM Warriors out of Winston Salem lost to North Texas in a tough battle. Sporting Charlotte TRFC from CPSL competed with the Wanderers FC for the Men's Over 40 title and Shot Callers took second in the Women's division having only lost to Winger FC.

Three motions for the board to consider tonight; (i) assisting teams heading to the Final Four in the Amateur Cup and Champions of Regions; (ii) ensuring the budget covers two officers traveling to the events; and (iii) approving the Celebrate the Tatas 2024 budget.

Vance Carlisle has communicated that he will be submitting his letter of resignation.

• Executive Director – Carolinas Cup (Charleston) has been the main focus. The event was fantastic; 74 teams, 12 divisions including two divisions of open teams and coed teams and 10 in the Over 50s, and two-women's divisions. NCASA provides significant support for this event in all stages.

TST was the next event. NCASA provided several email blasts to our membership regarding volunteering opportunities at the TST event.

We worked closely with all 7 NCASA teams traveling to the USASA Region III tournament.

Donna and Cindy have been working with TeamPass on several features to assist leagues and tournaments and the different reports that can be generated from the registration system.

- Executive Vice President No Report
- Treasurer Treasurer's report has been sent out. Income is tied to player registration and registration has been very positive. NCASA expenses are in line. Our income is 11% higher than where we were in 2023, 290 vs 270.

Single event registration has dropped but the NCASA Annual Registration numbers are strong thus compensating financially for the loss.

• Minutes for the May 20, 2024, NCASA Board meeting were approved unanimously.

Growth Initiative

- Registration Report The registrar's report has been circulated. NCASA numbers continue to be positive. There has been significant growth in several leagues, such as Wilmington has already exceeded their 2023 registration numbers.
- First Year Leagues Update Transylvania Ault Soccer Association has had an excellent start to their opening. Strong registration numbers that are continuing to grow.

Competitions

• Carolinas Cup (Charleston) – 74 teams, 12 divisions, 2 divisions of open, 2 divisions of coed, 2 divisions for women, 10 over 50 teams; the event was a success.

Carolinas Cup – The Winston-Salem contract is in its last year and the initial conversation has been had with NC Fusion about renewing the contract. Multiple budget scenarios have been drafted, and the committee will begin meeting to shape the event.

The Carolinas Cup assignor, Kevin Broadley has already put blocks on the dates for the Cup.

- Celebrate the Tatas Main focus is the budget. Registration date is still set for July 1.
- USASA Adult Soccer Fest Tom O'Shea and his crew have done a lot of great work in multiple areas. They have been recruiting teams, courting sponsors and vendors, picking out a band for the party and have created a souvenir bag for all the party attendees.

Approved Motions:

Celebrate the Tatas Budget

Whereas the Budgetary Spending Authority Policy requires the Celebrate the Tatas committee to present to the Board for approval a proposed budget describing how already budgeted funds of \$8,000 are expected to be spent no later than three months before the start date of the Celebrate the Tatas tournament;

Whereas the Budgetary Spending Authority Policy allows the Celebrate the Tatas committee to expend funds beyond the budgeted funds up to the amount of revenues from the event, and

Whereas the June 17, 2024, NCASA Board meeting is the final Board meeting occurring more than three months before the start date of the 2024 Celebrate the Tatas tournament,

Be it resolved that the Board authorizes the Celebrate the Tatas committee to spend the already budgeted funds of \$8,000, along with additional revenues from the event (e.g., sponsorships and donations, including in-kind donations), in a manner consistent with the following proposed budget:

Champions of Regions Team Travel Subsidy

Whereas, NCASA covered entry fees and provided travel subsidies to Carolinas Cup champions and finalists to assist with expenses to compete at the Region III championships,

Whereas, teams representing NCASA won three championships (Men's Amateur, Women's Amateur, & Men's Over 40) and also were finalists in three divisions (Women's Amateur, Men's Over 30, & Men's Over 40),

Whereas, the travel expenses for the two NCASA teams competing at the USASA Men's & Women's National Amateur Cup Final Fours on July 26-28, 2024, in Dekalb, Illinois, will have their travel expenses covered by USASA, and

Whereas, NCASA teams attending the Champions of Regions on August 16-18, 2024, in Murfreesboro, TN, may need financial support to attend the Champions of Regions, and NCASA wants to provide support to the teams attending the Champions of Regions,

Be it resolved that NCASA approves the spending of up to \$3,000 from the General Fund to help cover travel expenses for NCASA teams competing at the Champions of Regions, and

Be it further resolved that no more than \$1,000 will be provided to each team competing at the Champions of Regions.

National Final Four & Champions of Regions Board Member Travel Subsidy

Whereas, NCASA has one Men's Amateur team and one Women's Amateur team that have qualified for the National Amateur Cup Final Fours being held on July 26-28, 2024, in Dekalb, Illinois, based on their performance at the USASA Region III Championships,

Whereas, NCASA also has at least one team that has qualified for the Champions of Regions being held on August 16-18, 2024, in Murfreesboro, TN, based on their performance at the USASA Region III Championships, and

Whereas, designated NCASA representatives at these events can provide support and are able to help NCASA-affiliated teams with any onsite issues that may arise,

Be it resolved that NCASA approves the spending of up to an additional \$2,000 from the General Fund beyond the funds already approved in the 2024 NCASA budget to cover the expenses for up to two NCASA Board members to attend each of the National Final Four and the Champions of Regions.
