USASA National Cup Regional Championship will be held in Greenville, NC - June 7-9 **Reports by Member Leagues**

CVASA - Matthew Tremblay – Our largest year to date, holding three seasons of competition, spring, summer, and fall. Scheduling can be difficult because of field access issues, which adds to the difficulty in securing referees. CVASA decided to increase referee pay to help alleviate some of the issues.

ABASA - Felice Lopez Bell – ABASA increased referee pay; added new divisions, including an Over 50 division; and brought back the 11v11 format for Men's Open. Our player registration numbers are growing. We've been fortunate to not have any flooding issues this past year. We are offering our captains and referees CPR training. We have had a transgender issue come up and we are looking for guidance or precedence on this topic.

WWSL – Susan Morecroft – Our registration numbers exceeded our expectations. We hoped to offer Over 30 and Over 40, but decided to merge the two divisions in the Fall. Our plan is to offer the two divisions in the spring.

CPSL – **Jorge Mesquita** - We've started our spring season already. CPSL is having to book fields in South Carolina because of field availability issues in the Charlotte area.

WSASL – Mark Essman – We are in a rebuilding year. Competition around NC Fusion over fields and members. We have moved away from using the turf at NC Fusion and that has given us more freedom with scheduling. We are utilizing many school fields in the area. We are currently running 8v8 but working on bringing back our 11v11 division.

PASL - Siler Southerland – PASL has had a strong year. Secured fields in High Point and Kernersville. Captains are pleased by the state of the league. PASL increased referee pay and created a better, fun-oriented playing environment. All this helps with landing quality referees.

SSAAL - Zack Cowan - Player registration numbers are up, our open teams increased. Added an Over 30 division and a Women's Division. Increased referee pay as well and worked hard to reduce referee abuse. We are expanding our field search to school fields to help with growth.

PGSAAL – Scott Crass and Jamie Wigent – PSSAAL has worked hard at growing the league, and we've had success. Our numbers are very strong. Our open division has grown, and we've added a Women's division. We have also increased our referee pay to secure better-quality referees.

TASL – David Zabarsky – We've had a very good year. 19 divisions. We've continued to grow. Our current registrations for 2024 are higher than normal already. We've implemented an Emergency Plan for health incidences at the field, especially for our older divisions. TASL has increased referee fees, our new assignor, Jude Carr has been working to elevate referees for the adult game through man management to proper match report submission. Having games at the WRAL Soccer Center allows for games to be taped and reviewed. Jude Carr has completed 50 assessments. This has been a positive program for TASL as we have seen improvements.

MASL – Jeremy Mikell - Continuing to work to grow the league, this year MASL has topped 1000 players. 34 teams in spring, 36 teams in the fall. We have a Coed Commissioner that has done a great job. He has been huge in implementing the Discipline and Appeals committee. Communication has improved. We've caught teams photoshopping their rosters. The D&A committee took it very seriously and issued a very strong suspension. We have had a successful year. We are still working on the women's division. Queen City Cup will be held on the first weekend in August.

NC SRA Report - Presented by Paul James

Submitted the NCSRA Report stating the number of registered referees and the programs that NCSRA does to educate referees, retain referees and to recruit referees.
